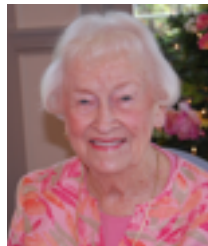

The treasurer reported a checking account balance of \$7,135.82 and a savings account balance of \$9,140.21. \$25 was collected for the Y.E.S. Club at the meeting. Louise Whitis moved and Diane Ganz seconded the motion to alternate our basket donations next year between Y.E.S. Club and Baskets of Life.

Eileen McNally reported that school district officials in our county were notified of our \$200 grant offer to fund a classroom project next fall. She has already received phone calls from interested teachers. Applications will be available the first of August and due the first of October. Recipients will be announced the middle of October.
